A. General

1. Definitions

- 1.1 'Data Controller' means the person responsible for the processing of personal data in accordance with art. 1, §4 Privacy Act and art. 4 (7) Privacy Regulation.
- 1.2 'Directive on privacy and electronic communications': *Directive 2002/58/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 July 2002 concerning the processing of personal data and the protection of privacy in the electronic communications sector*
- 1.3 'Google Analytics': for more information on Google Analytics visit <https://www.google.com/intl/en/analytics/>; to get the privacy statement of the Google Analytics services, visit <https://www.google.com/intl/en/policies/>
- 1.4 'Privacy Act' means the Act of 8 December 1992 concerning privacy in relation to the processing of personal data.
- 1.5 'Privacy Regulation': means the *Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)*
- 1.6 'Telecom Act': Belgian act concerning electronic communication of June 13th, 2005.
- 1.7 'Third-party cookie': a cookie that has been written and is being read by a party other than the operator of the website. The best known third-party cookies are those for statistics, such as Google Analytics cookies.
- 1.8 'Website' means the internet website(s) hosted at *.peepL.be, *.peepL.nl or *.peepL.io (used in singular even if this definition includes multiple sites).
- 1.9 'User', 'Data Subject', 'You' or 'Your' means any natural person who enters personal data on the Website.

2. Scope

- 2.1 This Cookie Statement applies to all cookies processed on the Website.
- 2.2 This Cookie Statement is provided to You in accordance with article 129 Telecom Act and ar. 6 (3) Directive on privacy and electronic communications.

C. General purpose and use of Cookies

5. The purpose of cookies

- 5.1 A cookie is a small amount of data that a Website, via the server where it is hosted, sends to the browser of the User with the intention to save this data to the computer of the User. The content of such a cookie can be short (eg. 'EN' for a cookie that remembers your choice of language) or relatively long (eg. IP addresses, shopping cart contents, etc.). On a return visit to this site, the server can recognize the browser of the previous visitor and access the information stored on the visitor's computer in the past.
- 5.2 In case of first-party cookies, the information by means of a cookie saved and stored on the computer of the visitor, is fully controlled by the Data Controller. In case of third-party cookies, the Data Controller has no such control.
6. Usage examples
- 6.1 The use of cookies has demonstrated its usefulness in mainly, for example:
- remembering login name or settings (e.g. language.)
 - collecting information surf (populated fields, pages visited, etc.);
 - tracking site statistics (number of visitors, etc.);
 - coupling a browser to temporary variables on the server (session cookie);
 - etc.
- 6.2 Some cookies fulfill some technical purposes (eg. a session cookie, which e.g. allows you to preserve the content of a basket when surfing on an e-commerce site) while other cookies contain substantive information (eg. language, form fields, content basket, etc.).
- 6.3 In short, cookies make it possible to surf on the one hand, and on the other hand provide for a better and easier browsing experience.
